Prior to joining MacEwan University, he held academic appointments at Addis Ababa University (Ethiopia), the University of Alberta, and the University of Windsor. Dr. Ferede's research program focuses on taxation policy, intergovernmental fiscal relations and economic growth. His work also examines the efficiency costs of taxation, the economic effects of tax policies and tax reform.

His research has been published in leading peer reviewed journals, including the *National Tax Journal*, *International Tax and Public Finance*, *Small Business Economics* and *Public Finance Review*.
