Hugh Stephens is currently Vice Chair of the Canadian Committee on Pacific Economic Cooperation (CANCPEC), a Distinguished Fellow at the Asia Pacific Foundation of Canada and an Executive Fellow at the School of Public Policy at the University of Calgary.

During his almost 30-year career in the Canadian foreign service, he served at Canadian missions in Beirut, Hong Kong, Beijing, Islamabad, Seoul and Taipei (as Head of Mission), and as Assistant Deputy Minister for Policy and Communications at the Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade in Ottawa. In 2001, he became Senior Vice President (Public Policy) for Asia-Pacific for Time Warner based in Hong Kong. He moved to Victoria, BC in 2010 where he currently resides. He has written extensively on Canada's engagement with the Asia Pacific region in *The Globe and Mail*, *National Post*, *Ottawa Citizen*, *iPolitics*, *The Diplomat*, *Open Canada*, and others.



He was educated at the University of British Columbia (BA-Hons), Duke University (MA), and the University of Toronto (BEd).
