Tristan Skolrud is an associate professor in the Department of Agricultural and Resource Economics at the University of Saskatchewan. His research focuses on farm-level decision making, productivity, agri-environmental policy, and the role of institutions in achieving welfare-maximizing outcomes.

Tristan has published in leading journals in the fields of agricultural and resource economics, including the *American Journal of Agricultural Economics*, the *Canadian Journal of Agricultural Economics*, the *Journal of Agricultural and Resource Economics*, and *Energy Economics*.

Born and raised in Washington State, Tristan received a PhD in economics from Washington State University in 2015 and an MA in economics from the University of Washington in 2011. At the University of Saskatchewan, Tristan teaches courses in agricultural finance and microeconomic theory.
