Jennifer A Quaid, B Soc Sci (Econ) (Ottawa), LL.L/LL.B. (Ottawa), LLM (Cantab), LLM (Columbia), PhD (Queen's), is an Associate Professor in the Civil Law Section at the University of Ottawa's Faculty of Law where she teaches criminal law, competition law and business law.

Widely recognized for her scholarly contributions and public policy engagement, Prof. Quaid's expertise is centered on the use of law and regulation to enhance business accountability and to promote responsible management and commercial practices. Her current research projects focus on four areas: (1) competition law, market regulation and the digital economy, (2) regulation of business activity, including in relation to artificial intelligence, (3) economic crime and anti-corruption law; and (4) organizational criminal law.

A member of the Bars of Québec, Ontario and New York, Prof. Quaid practiced law for several years, first with the federal Department of Justice and then in private practice for a leading New York firm before joining the academy. She clerked for the Hon. Frank Iacobucci of the Supreme Court of Canada.

Prof. Quaid is a Senior Fellow at the Centre for International Governance Innovation (CIGI). She is a member of Transparency International Canada and the current Chair of its Legal Committee. She was a member of the Board of Governors of the University of Ottawa from 2018-2021.
